Who is Eligible?

Participants must be 18 years of age or older, working, looking for work or in enrolled in school. Tech Connect classes are free to those who qualify based on income. They must live at or below 200% of the federal poverty line.

For 2020, 200% of the FPL is \$52,400 for a family of four. These guidelines are updated annually. Call LCCAA to make certain you qualify.

Documentation requirements include:

- Photo ID and Social Security card for all household members
- Proof of income for last 90 days
- Class Schedule
- OhioMeansJobs orientation
- SNAP benefit letter



Over Income Students

As a resident of Lorain County and a member of our community you can take advantage of Tech Connect training.

If you do not qualify based on income and there is room in the class, you can attend for \$10 per class or a total of \$80. Payment must be made prior to the first class and submitted to LCCAA, not the instructor.
